Minutes

Roll Call: Mayor Tommy Ortiz ó Present Mayor Pro-Tem Sam Smith - Present

Call to Order:

- 1) Mayor Ortiz called the regular city council meeting to order at 7:00 pm; followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Alderwoman Vera and Invocation by Alderman Bluemel.

Citizens to be Heard:

- 2) Emilio Flores expressed concerns regarding the city's continuous infrastructure failing issues, in addition to remarks of the Mayor and City Administrator's lack of regards of city issues.

City Council Comments:

- 3) Alderman Smith asked if the City/NISD can look into getting a stop sign installed at 9th/Miller Street at schools driveway intersecting Miller Street; schools use of this portion of 9th Street has become an issue since the rerouting of traffic. Alderman Fernandez had a few concerns regarding the barricade at 4th/Miller, and the boring conducted by QRO Mex Construction of which he'd like for Public Works Director Art Smith to contact him to discuss further.

Presentations:

- 4) City Secretary administered the Oath of Office to three (3) unopposed officials of the City of Natalia, Texas, resulting in the cancellation of the City's November 2019 General Election, for two-year terms expiring November 2021: (Mayor) Tommy F. Ortiz; (Aldermen) Samuel C. Bluemel and Darin Frazier.

Consent Agenda:

Action: Alderman Fernandez made the motion approving the consent agenda, and Alderman Bluemel seconded the motion. Vote: 5-0; Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion/Consideration of Action Items:

- 6) **Discuss/Consider Electing an Alderman to serve as Mayor Pro-Tem for a one (1) year term ending November 2020.**

Action: Alderman Bluemel made a motion nominating Alderman Sam Smith to serve as Mayor Pro-Tem until November 2020; and Alderman Fernandez seconded the motion. Alderman Smith accepted the nomination. Vote: Without further nominees, motion passed unanimously by a 5-0 vote.

- 7) **Introduction/Discussion/Consideration of Appointing Officers to the Natalia Police Department, and Administering the Oaths of Office to:**

Introduction of each Officer was presented by Chief Glenn Barrow, and recommending their appointment:

- i. **Marie Trujillo, Police Officer (Full-time)**
- ii. **Joseph McKay, Code Enforcement Officer (Part-time)**
- iii. **Glenn Harlow, Reserve Police Officer**
- iv. **Ivan Diaz, Reserve Police Officer**

Action: Without objection, Mayor Ortiz administered the Oath of Office to the Police Officers listed above.

- 8) **Discuss/Consider a Resolution; Allocating votes for the nomination of a candidate for the election of Medina County Appraisal Board of Directors for a two-year term, January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021.**

Action: Alderman Smith made a motion allocating the City's 25-votes to Roy Sheetz, a 2020-21 candidate of the Medina County Appraisal District Board; and Alderman Fernandez second the motion. Vote: Motion passed unanimously by a 5-0 vote.
